Tourette's syndrome and epilepsy inspired him to write the highly acclaimed novel *Jerk, California*, winner of the American Library Association's 2009 Schneider Award—"Best Book for Teens." Jonathan has served on the board of the Minnesota Tourette Syndrome Association.

Jonathan spent sixteen years teaching in regular education, special education, and university settings, and now travels the country sharing his expertise and heart for the hurting with audiences of all ages. Engaging and passionate, Jonathan's presentations have touched students and educators, parents and professionals across North America.
