December 8, David Horton, Bethany House Editor Writing an Effective Book Proposal



You have a great idea for a book. How can you catch the attention of publishers, acquisition editors, or literary agents? What do you need? A book proposal.

Naturally, there are several steps, but one of the most fundamental is an effective book proposal.

David Horton has spent more than

two decades acquiring and editing fiction and nonfiction books. He is currently Vice President, Editorial at Bethany House Publishers in Bloomington, Minnesota.

On December 8, David Horton will discuss what works and what doesn't in presenting yourself and your work to a prospective publisher. His presentation will help you move from who you are—a writer with a great idea—to who you want to be—a writer with a published book.

A former businessman, mission executive, and missionary to France, Horton is also a published author. He and his wife, Jennifer, have two grown children and four grandchildren. The Hortons make their home in the Twin Cities' south suburbs.

Bethany House, recognized as the pioneer and leader in Christian fiction, is part of Baker Publishing Group.

Act of Encouragement

Seasons change quickly in Minnesota! When our gentle fall gave way to a blizzard overnight, I felt rather discouraged having to cancel November's meeting, until I read the next portion of our 2014-15 theme verse: "and the encouragement of the Scripture." So I opened my Bible and studied passages on *encouragement* and *courage* to rediscover the source and purpose for both.

The phrase *be strong and courageous* is often coupled with reminders that God is with us and will not forsake us. Two verses in Deuteronomy and one in Joshua base the exhortation on the fact that God has sworn to do as He says. That makes for solid encouragement, don't you think?

We need authentic, godly encouragement to stay the course in our publishing journeys, just as Joshua did when he faced big tasks or battles. Yet Scriptures such as 1 Chronicles 28:20, "Be strong and courageous and act," remind us to do something with our God-breathed courage. Isaiah 35:3 says, "Encourage the exhausted, and strengthen the feeble." We, as Christian writers, face enormous spiritual battles, as well as daily obstacles to safeguard writing time. Praying for one another is wonderful encouragement.

At our December meeting we will celebrate the professional skills and accomplishments of our members. As we visit the tables and talk shop, let's remind one another of God's faithfulness. We all need support along this publishing journey. Reach out to one another. If you want to join a critique group, let others know. If you have room in your critique group, announce it. Be courageous and act!

God's promised presence and strength enables us to pass along His encouragement to others. In this season—and beyond—we find encouragement in the precious gift of God's Word and in the gift of supporting one another.
